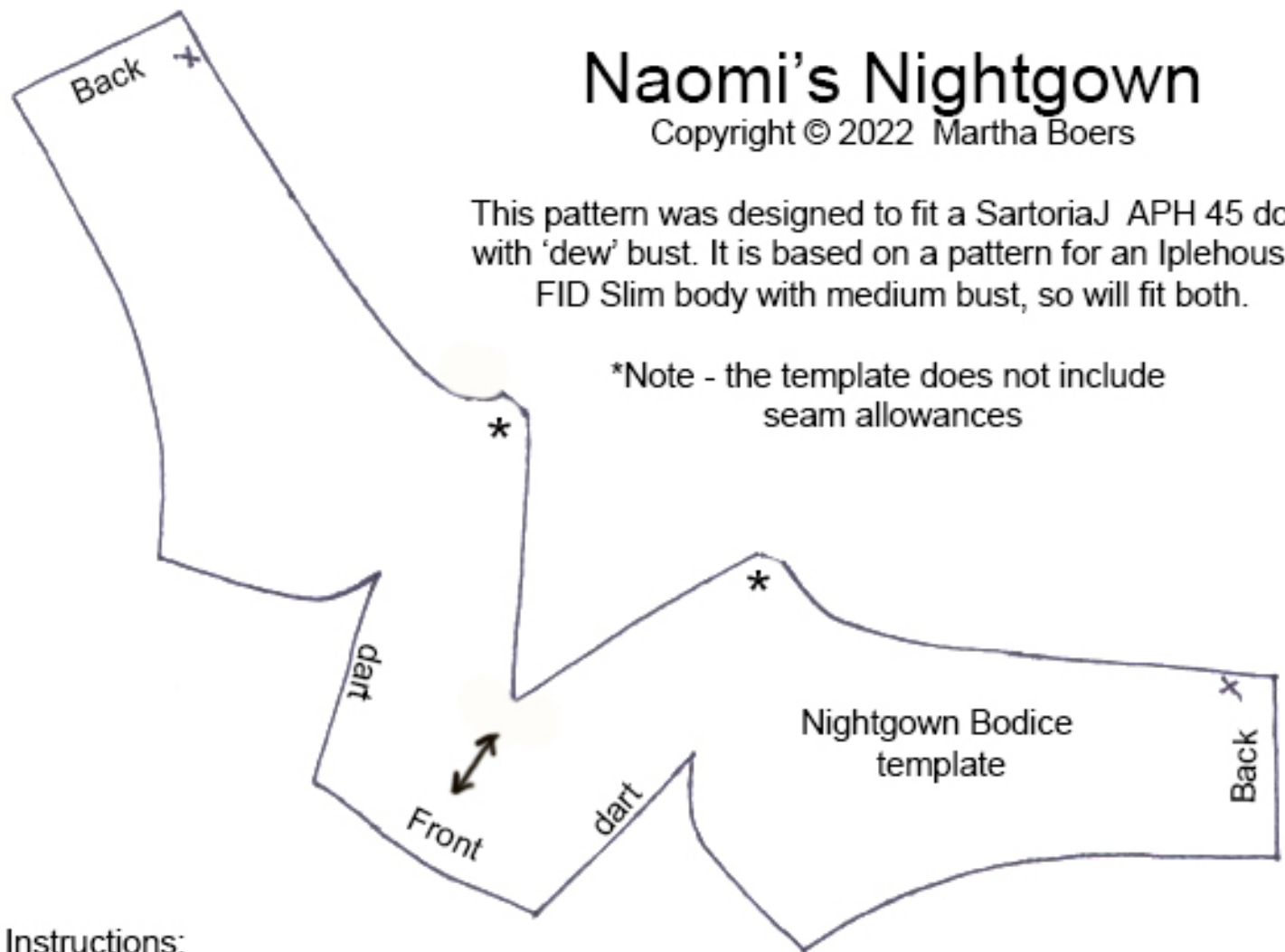


Naomi's Nightgown

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This pattern was designed to fit a SartoriaJ APH 45 doll with 'dew' bust. It is based on a pattern for an Iplehouse FID Slim body with medium bust, so will fit both.

*Note - the template does not include seam allowances



Instructions;

I used fabric from a nylon tricot slip, and cut the 12" x 30" skirt from the bottom of the slip with the finished hem edge. Otherwise add 1/2" to length for hemming..

1. Trace template onto wrong side of fabric using a Pilot Frixion pen (the ink will disappear with the heat from an iron)
2. Cut out two bodice pieces with right sides together, adding the seam allowances.
3. Cut two 4" lengths of 1/8" wide ribbon for the straps. Pin ribbons between layers at the stars.
4. Stitch the layers together starting at one back side, then up along the top edge, and down the other back side. Clip, the curves.
5. Sew the darts. Clip the curves. Turn bodice right side out and press (with cloth).
6. Hem sides and bottom of skirt fabric.
7. With right sides together, gather the skirt onto the front bodice layer. Clip curve and zig zag edge.
8. Fold inner bodice layer seam allowance inwards over the gathered skirt edge and stitch down by hand.
9. Sew backs of skirt together 2/3 of the way up.
10. Sew the ribbon straps to the back of the bodice. The straps should measure 3"
11. Embellish neckline with lace and/or embroidery, and sew on snaps.
